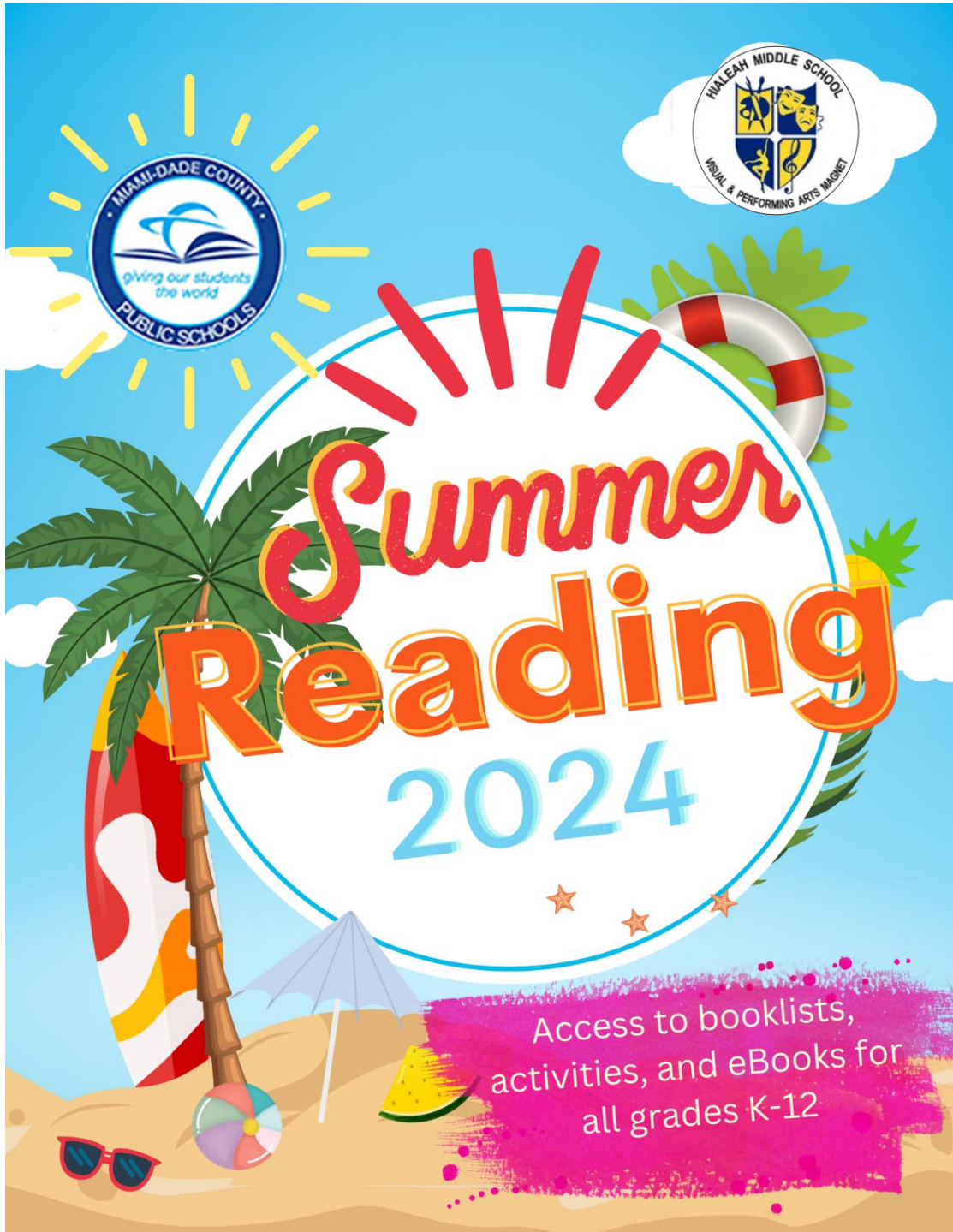

Summer Reading Assignment

Directions: Read your grade level assigned book and complete the three assignments listed below. Your assignments can be completed electronically or on paper. You will submit the three assignments to your 2024-2025 Language Arts teacher when school opens in August. Each assignment is worth one grade so this project = three grades.

- 1. Reading Log:** Complete a Reading log for your novel reading. You must have at least 10 dates logged in for reading. Your log must have the date, the starting and ending page numbers and a 5-6 sentence summary of what you read about that day.
- 2. Essay Writing:** A classic novel is a book that has stood the test of time because it's so good; it has a gripping story which is expertly crafted and brilliantly expressed. Write a three-paragraph (Introduction, Body and Conclusion) argumentative essay, arguing whether your grade level book should be considered a classic novel. Be sure to cite specific evidence from the novel to support your claim.
- 3. Find a song that relates to your book (character, theme, setting, plot etc.).** Write the Song title and the name of recording artist/band. Then write a 5-6 sentence paragraph to explain how this song relates to your novel. Be sure to cite specific evidence from the book to support your song choice.
